## **GETTING TO CHARLOTTE PLAINS**

- Stars of Charlotte Plains will be held at the Bore Campsite.
- The Bore Campsite is located 4km off the highway, ~50km (40 mins) from Cunnamulla, or ~135km (1.5hrs) from Bollon.
- If possible, avoid travelling late afternoon or evening as kangaroos come out to feed in the table drains along the edges of the highway.
- Fuel: If you are travelling from the East, we recommend filling up at St George or Bollon.
- <u>Where To Stop from Brisbane to Cunnamulla</u>

#### **ENTRY AND EXIT TIMES**

- Please have your booking confirmation ready for easy check in at the Bore Campsite. We recommend taking a screenshot prior to your arrival.
- Check in is from 12pm (unless you are booked to stay prior).
- Check out is before 12pm (unless you are booked to stay longer).
- If you need to leave early, you are welcome to, but we are unable to offer refunds. Our refund policy can be found <u>here.</u>

#### **KEY FESTIVAL RULES**

- Standard campground rules apply.
- No BYO alcohol in the main festival area (located near Bar, Stage, Bore).
- Dogs are not allowed in the main festival area to ensure a positive experience for all. If travelling with your dog, they must be well-behaved when left at your campsite and able to cope with loud noises.

## CAMP SITES

- Camp Sites are not allocated, so you can choose where to setup on arrival.
- Do not camp within 20m of the bore drain, or in areas marked as no camping or reserved.
- We have plenty of space so there is no need to crowd other campers.
- For a quieter experience, we recommend camping further from the main festival area.

#### **CAN I CAMP WITH FRIENDS?**

If you would like to camp as a group with other vehicles, we recommend arriving at the Bore Campsite together as it could be difficult to save spots for late arrivals.

## WHAT ARE THE PROPERTY ROADS LIKE?

- If you are staying at the Bore Campsite, there is 4KM of unsealed, good dirt road coming off the bitumen highway at the Creek Road (Widgeegoara) entrance.
- Please download the Property Map in your email confirmation, prior to arrival. This shows other distances around the property.
- All roads are perfectly suitable for 2 wheel drive vehicles, as long as there hasn't been any recent rain. Roads are flat and generally in good condition.

#### DO I NEED TO BOOK THE HOT ARTESIAN BATHS?

- No bookings are required for our hot artesian baths. Please be considerate to other guests, wishing to have a bath.
- Due to the mineral content of the water and the 40°C temperature, it is recommended to only stay in the tubs/water for 20 minutes.



## **AMENITIES**

#### LICENSED BAR

- Our licensed bar has beverages available for purchase, including beer, wine, spirits, and soft drinks.
- EFTPOS only, no cash.
- There is no BYO in the main festival area.

#### FOOD VENDORS

- Our food vendors have items available for purchase throughout the festival.
- Outback Grazing & Co coffee, breakfast, and woodfired pizzas.
- Outback Food Shack coffee, breakfast, burgers, loaded fries, fish & chips, chicken nuggets, dagwood dog, and mini pancakes.
- We will also have a fundraising lamb on the spit on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> June.

#### SHOWERS

- The Bore Campsite has three private showers, and public bath tubs dotted along the bore.
- The showers/baths use warm water straight from the artesian bore. As such, there are no taps that control the temperature.
- Due to numbers of festival goers, please use your own shower if you have. Bore water can be potted to use for your caravan or campsite.

#### TOILETS

• There are flushing toilets and several long drops around the Campsite.

#### WATER

- There is Artesian water with taps at the shed, toilet block, and washing up area.
- Artesian water is suitable to drink and can be potted to use for your caravan or campsite.
- Please bring bottled water, if you don't like the taste.

#### WIFI AND SERVICE

- There is satellite internet and WIFI, however, this may be limited due to bandwidth.
- 10 mins of free WIFI in one sitting. After that, \$10 flat fee for 5GB.
- Please note: There is no 3G, 4G, or 5G coverage.
- We are on UHF 26.

#### PHOTOGRAPHY AND DRONES

- By attending the festival, you consent to being captured in official photography and video footage, which may be used for promotional purposes.
- For safety and privacy reasons, no personal drones are permitted unless prior approval has been granted by festival organisers.

#### CAMPFIRES

- Fires are permitted and wood can be collected around the property.
- Please do not take wood from the main festival area.
- Keep campfires at a moderate size and a safe distance from vehicles, vans, trailers and tents.
- Accident Prevention: Do not bury fires. Make sure you douse them in water before leaving AND leave them exposed for other campers to see where they are.

#### GENERATORS

- It is recommended to bring your own generator if necessary.
- There is NO 240V power available.
- Generators are permitted between 8am 8pm (festival organisers and vendors excluded).

## **PACKING LIST**

- Broad brim hat as there is limited shade (we have CP caps for sale!)
- Bring and 'name' your own Camp Chair (for the music and your campsite)
- Place to sleep (tent/swag/camper trailer/camper van/caravan)
- Bedding (mattress, pillows, sleeping bags/linen)
- Lighting (torch and spare batteries, camp lanterns)
- Clothing:
  - FACT: Temperatures overnight in June are generally between 3-9°C
  - Flannel/work shirts
  - Shorts and Long pants/jeans
  - Thick/heavy jacket/jumpers/coat/puffer
  - Underwear and thick socks
  - Extra warm PJ's
  - Swimmers
  - Colourful outfit for the Themed Fun Run!
  - Outfit for Wild Stars of the West on Saturday!
- Shoes
  - Crocs/thongs: lots of prickles in the dirt and easy to slip on
  - Runners/sneakers/work boots
  - Old pair of runners for the Fun Run (they will get wet and muddy)!
- Toiletries
  - Usual essentials
  - Sunscreen
  - Moisturiser (the Artesian water is full of wonderful minerals but can be slightly drying on the skin)
- Food (there will also be food vendors onsite)
- Alcohol glass-free preferable (there is a licensed bar onsite and there is NO BYO in the main festival area)
- Drinking water (if you don't like the taste of artesian water)
- Rubbish bags
- Ice (if required)
- Photo ID (if you look under 25 for liquor licensing)
- A small bucket (great for the kids to use when on the Yabby Delve)
